Best new courses

Marquette Golf Club (Greywalls Course) Marquette, Mich.

MICHIGAN'S Upper Peninsula offers an all-too-brief season, but what it lacks in quantity it makes up for in quality, especially with this year's addition of the Greywalls course at Marquette Golf Club. Architect Mike DeVries grabbed this rugged site by the shoulders and shook loose 18 distinctive challenges in a rough-and-tumble layout.

DeVries used the exposed granite here in every way possible—as jagged hazards alongside the fairways and as aiming points behind greens. Views of Lake Superior greet you on the first tee, and everything that follows—from the approach on the 579-yard par-5 first to the forested, downhill, saddle-shaped 18th fairway—lives up to the lake's name. Potential disasters loom throughout the round. DeVries accomplished a minor miracle in routing such a variety of holes on such a difficult site, and you'll tip your hard hat to his labors.
